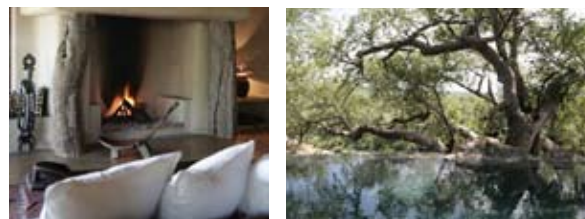
Kgoro Lodge and Kgoro House afford visitors the unique experience of merging with the captivating heartbeat of Africa.

How to get to us

SCHEDULED FLIGHTS

Airlink Airways offers a number of daily return flights between Johannesburg's O.R. Tambo Airport and Phalaborwa, plus a daily nonstop return flight from Mpumalanga and Cape Town International Airports. Alternatively there are daily return flights from Johannesburg's O.R. Tambo Airport to Hoedspruit with land transfer (under an hour) to the Lodge.

CHARTER FLIGHTS

Flights can be chartered directly to the Makalali Airstrip from Mpumalanga International and Johannesburg's O.R. Tambo Airport.

Private executive jet charters can be arranged to Phalaborwa from any airport in South Africa, or from overseas (clearing customs and immigration in Polokwane)

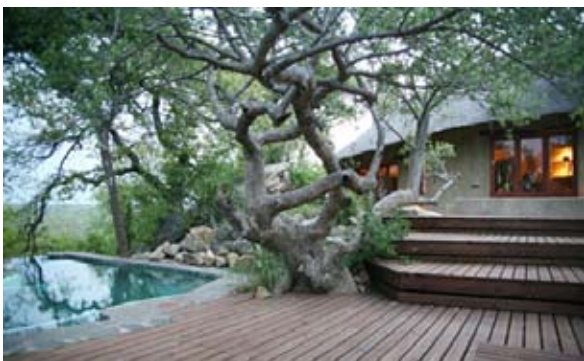
DRIVING

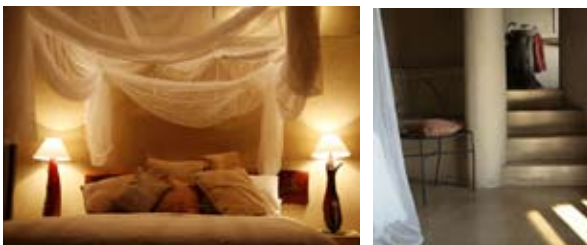
KGORO LODGE
